

# **Multi Academy Trust**

On Wednesday 11th Senior Leaders from the MAT including Trustees monitored behaviours for learning in all 3 schools. These were found to be very positive across the MAT.

- Learning & differentiation well matched to learners' needs within mixed aged classes
  - Pupils' behaviour and response to routines is excellent
  - Mixed aged classes give strong opportunities for extended learning
    - Pupil peer support is positive
