Important - School Dinner- New pre_ ordering system

From Monday 27 November we will be moving to a pre-order system for all our school lunches through the Schoolcomms payment system. This system will be in place for orders made after Friday 24 November for menu choices from Monday 27 November.

The price of the meal will remain at £2.41 for Nursery and Key Stage 2 children. Children in Key Stage 1 and those in receipt of Free School Meals will continue to be entitled to a free meal each day but are still required to make the food choice selection.

Each week's menu will be uploaded into Schoolcomms and you will be able to view the menu options. You will need to select your child's choice for each day and confirm with payment. No selection is confirmed until payment is made.

Each day's food choice will need to be confirmed by 8.30am on the day. You can book as far in advance as you wish to. If you forget to pre-book your child's meal they will be provided with the pasta option for that day and you will be notified that you need to make payment.

There may be occasions when the menu is altered for theme days. We will let you know in advance through our usual communications when these occur.
