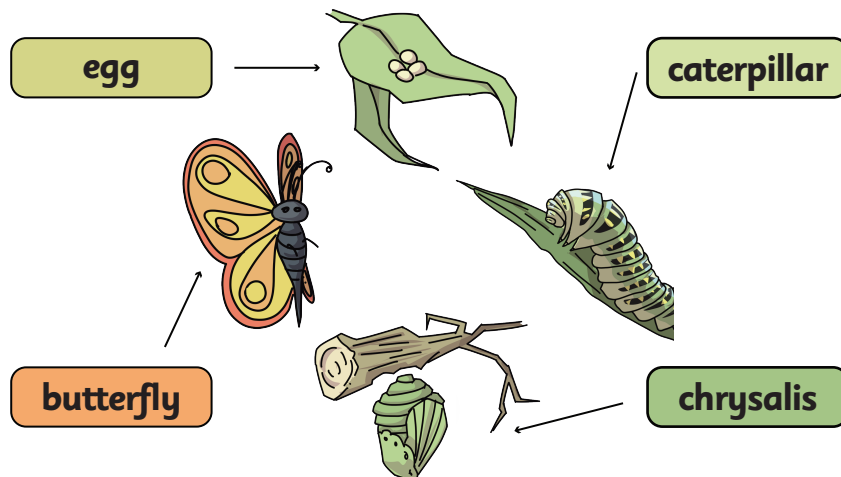

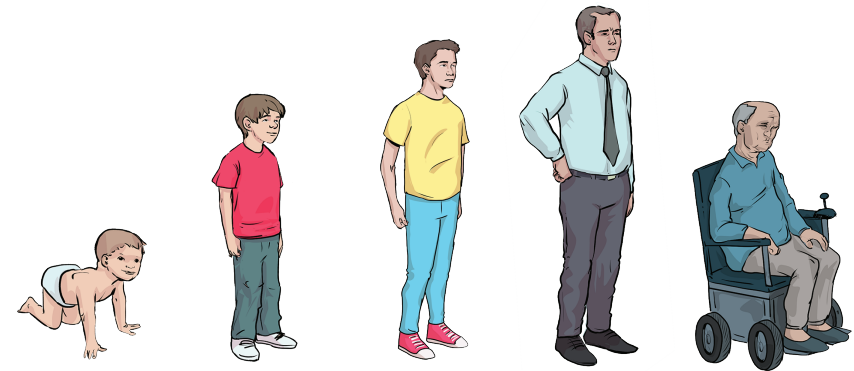
All living things **have basic needs**.

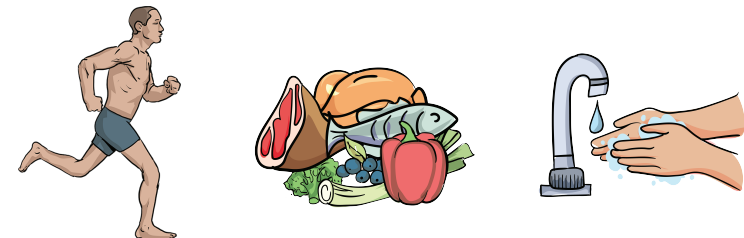

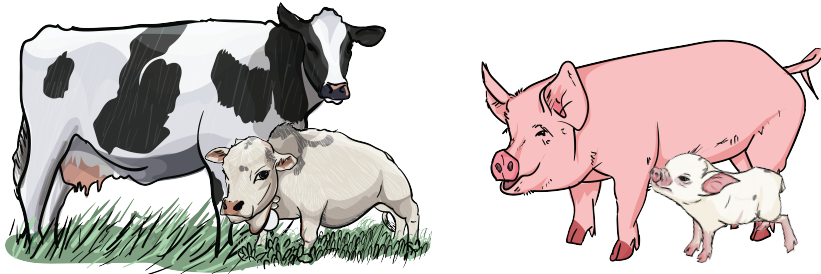
How can we look after ourselves?

We can **exercise regularly**, eat **a healthy diet** and make sure we have **good hygiene**.

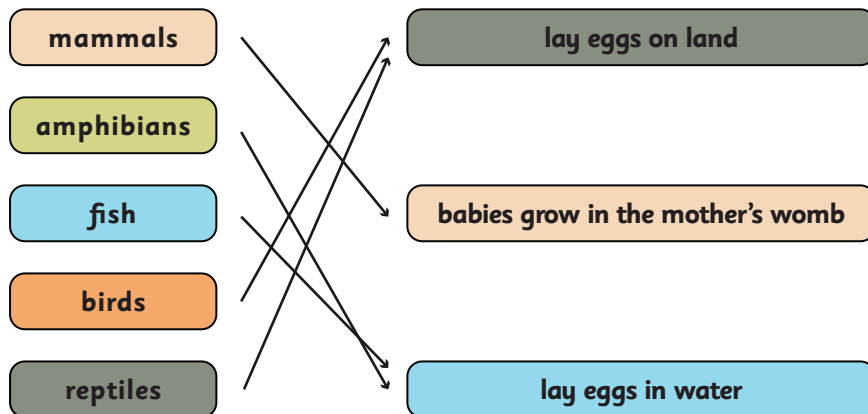


Offspring
