

| Hindi | The language usually used in Bollywood films. |

| Playback singers | Famous Bollywood actors mime the songs, which are actually sung by 'playback' singers. |
| Sound effect | An artificially created sound that represents what is happening in a film. |
| Harmony | When two or more notes sound at the same time, and usually sound nice together. |
| Performance direction | Symbols or words on sheet music that describe how music should be played, eg the dynamics or tempo. |


