

It has been a busy week here in school with lots of exciting learning taking place. On Wednesday, our Y5 children were excellent ambassadors for our school when they visited Truro to attend the Junior Life Skills workshop. The children learnt about the role of agencies (such as the police, fire service and traffic enforcement officers) play in keeping us safe. Children in Year 1 and 2 have been extending their understanding in addition and subtraction and have worked collaboratively to support one another in their learning.


Our stories based on Town Mouse and Country Mouse are well under way and the children have worked extremely hard to apply new learning.
